**Following decisions were taken in the meeting:**

1. A bidder shall be allowed for multiple bidding with one team, however only one work shall be considered for award against one team.
2. As per the clause-1.3.5 of LOI, It was further clarified that a bidder shall be awarded the work of maximum three clusters only, despite its bidding in any or all 15 clusters depending upon the sets of team available with the bidder. For

example, if a bidder intends to work in one cluster, he shall have to use minimum one team. If a bidder intends to work in two clusters, he shall have to use minimum two teams and if a bidder intends to work in three clusters he shall have to use minimum three teams despite participating in multiple clusters.

3. In continuation to clause-1.3.6, it is further clarified that the financial bid shall be opened in the sequence of cluster-6 to cluster-20 and whenever a bidder acquires top rank in any of the cluster with a set of team, its financial bids of other clusters with the same set of team shall not be opened. However its further bids with second, third or any other teams (If any) shall be processed in the above describedmanner.
4. The last date for the submission of technical bid has been rescheduled as follows:

5. In reference to clause-3 (xiii), page-17 it was made clear that the payment to SQC shall be made to the consultant on the men month basis on recommendation of PIU with regard to physical progress of work, performance of SQC and need of SQC team in PIU.
6. In reference to clause-10A (Note), the first line of the note shall be read as follows:-  
  
“Details of annul turn over in terms of PMC/SQC Fee (Annexure-IV), for financial years”.
7. In reference to the clause-3(v) of TOR, the period of communication for postponement and re-start of services has been extended to 30 days in place of existing provision of three weeks.

8. In reference to clause-16.1 of TOR, the existing line “**list of apparatus required for each Field Engineer**” shall be read as “**list of apparatus required for Material Engineer**”.
9. In reference to clause-5.1.8 of RFP, this clause shall be read as “**Bid must be valid for 120 days from the date of opening of technical bid**”.
10. In cluster No.6 (Indore) & 7 (Bhopal) the Point-C of Annexure-V the number of four wheeler rental shall be read as 3 in place of 2.
11. The FE, ARE and QS shall be provided with a two wheeler to each officers. The hiring and running expenses of these vehicles shall be deemed to have been included by consultant in out of pocket expenses item of bid.
